In this role, the primary responsibility is delivering innovative, hands-on, inquiry-based learning experiences for K-3 or 4-8 grade students at Talcott Mountain Science Center. Courses are one week in length, running from June 19 through August 11, 2023. Instructional topics may include:

LEGO robotics, Arduino, Raspberry Pi, 3D design/printing, filmmaking, Earth science, space science, engineering, genetics, bioengineering, LEGO science, meteorology, computer game making, green energy, chemistry, computer graphics, animation, marine science, rocketry, geocaching, and coding.

Instruction will include classroom, lab, and field settings on campus and field trips for certain courses. In addition to instructional duties, this role also encompasses student supervision for campus-wide activities, games, contests & presentations, and lunch & recess periods. Participation in regular staff meetings will also be required.

The successful candidate will be an innovative and inspiring teacher with passion and expertise in one or more of the above topics. In addition to at least a high school diploma or a degree in a related field, the successful candidate will possess solid classroom, group instruction, and/or outreach experience. Teaching certification is not required. The successful candidate must possess a valid driver's license, have access to reliable transportation, and successfully complete a background check.
