Charmaine started in advertising media at age 16. She attended journalism school.

CV Media seeks to get their clients the biggest bang for their media bucks. She finds that frequently people don't really know what they are getting when they buy advertising. Anyone can sell advertising since there is no licensing or certification required. When buying, you need to know what measures exist to show the results you might reasonably expect—circulation, reach, how many printed. Watch out for people trying to sell you advertising through social media, online and telephone calls.

She deals with all kinds of media. It is constantly changing and evolving. It is important to make sure you get what you pay for. Start by asking for the information you need to assure you reach your target audience whether through TV, Cable or Radio. You are paying for impressions. Online that means how many people go to the site each month? In print, especially good for reaching older consumers, it is circulation. Outdoor advertising boards don't tell your story and tend to be expensive. With respect to radio, it has a very broad reach but if your target audience is in a small geographic area, radio is probably not the right choice for you.

There are good qualified companies specializing in using social and online media advertising—Avon Chamber member Red Barn Consulting is an example. One advantage of using online advertising is that you can really target the people you most want to reach right down to individual Zip Codes. Online, you can target people using apps which serve ads based on age, sex, location, income, etc. You can also geofence your competitors to draw their customers to you.

CV Media helps clients choose the right advertising for what you want to accomplish. In addition, they help you assure consistency of message over time while keeping your name out there.

Annette DiClemente says hiring CV Media has reduced her stress in part because she refers people trying to get her business to Charmaine. This has actually reduced the number of calls she now gets.
